Indigenous Strategic Planning Online

May 18 - 21, 2021
Deadline: May 10

Research and best practices indicate that successful Indigenous nations and organizations are those that set clear visions, strategic direction and long-term goals. Indigenous Strategic Planning will prepare you to implement a community, organization, or board strategic planning process and session; help you focus resources on specific strategies; and provide an understanding of how to keep the plan alive through evaluation.

Indigenous Evaluations Frameworks Online

June 15 - 18, 2021
Deadline: June 7, 2021

Following Right Relations and the Wise Practices leadership and governance model, this program explores how accountable leaders act as stewards of a vision, uniting good governance and ethical practices while honoring their identity and culture.

Negotiation Skills Training Online

June 1 -4, 2021

Many Indigenous communities and organizations are in negotiations, or are preparing to negotiate, on important issues such as land claims, self-governance, fiscal arrangements, natural resources co-management agreements, and business partnerships. You will learn and practice each step in the negotiation process by using proven interest-based negotiation techniques.

Truth and Reconciliation Through Right Relations Online

June 22 - 25, 2021
Deadline: June 15, 2021

This online intensive provides a space for engaged, participatory learning through ceremony, the land, elders teachings, knowledge sharing, application of theory and tools, case clinics, storytelling and deep listening,; individual reflection, group dialogue and sensemaking, while balancing asynchronous and synchronous learning.
